**Job Title:** FADO III – Tower Operator/Driver  
**Department:** Career Services  
**Supplement To:** FADO I & FADO II & EMT/FF, PM/FF, Lieutenant Or Captain

**Essential Functions:**

- Responds to calls for service utilizing appropriate response guidelines and profiles
- Safely Drives vehicle according to SFC policies and State Laws
- Operates equipment correctly and properly
- Reports deficiencies to supervisor and tags equipment appropriately
- Performs other duties as assigned

**Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:**

- Knowledge of fire service pump hydraulics
- Knowledge of preventative maintenance of fire apparatus to include daily/weekly check
- Knowledge of SFC response profiles
- Knowledge of SFC area, to include hydrant and non-hydrant areas
- Knowledge of limitations of vehicle, including weight, height, and length as it pertains to response area
- Knowledge of all equipment carried on respective apparatus and how to properly operate same
- Knowledge of specifications of unit such as ladder weight capacity/person capacity, water tower applications
- Skill to operate vehicle in a safe and efficient manner
- Skill to operate tower ladder for ventilation (horizontal and vertical), rescue, and tower ladder pipe operations
- Skill to operate equipment on apparatus
- Ability to operate apparatus and equipment carried on responding unit
- Ability to follow Career Services rules, regulations, policies and operating procedures.

**Minimum Requirements:**

- Class B Non-Commercial License
- Emergency Vehicle Operator Course
- For Tower
  - Recommendation of Chief Engineer
  - Cleared to operate all Engines for SFC, Rescue, and Tanker
  - NFPA 1002 equivalent
    - Aerial Apparatus Operator Course
  - NFPA 1041
    - Truck Company Operations Course
